What do I do when I get there?

Once you have arrived please head over to the welcome desk to receive your passes and items included in the pass i.e lanyard prints etc.

Where do I get the lanyard I paid for?

When you have got your passes scanned please head over to the Thames Con Merch stall in the fantasy market to pick up any pre orders and paid lanyards.



We recommend having some cash on you for the day. The nearest cash points will be in High Wycombe.

Card Payments:

Can I park there?
